The predecessors of the Institute of Art History (IAH) and the Institute of Theatre and Film Research (ITFR) were established in the Slovak Academy of Sciences as early as 1953, and therefore they are institutes with a long tradition in their scientific field, not only in Slovakia. For 70 years, these institutes have worked on many research projects, published a large number of publications, participated in the international scientific context, continuously publish the only Slovak scientific journals in their field (ARS <http://www.dejum.SAS.sk/?section=magazine> and Slovak Theatre <https://sd.SAS.sk/o-casopise/>), have been involved in the pedagogical process, etc. Societal and political changes, evolution and innovation over such a long period of time, as well as the desire of the bureaucracy to find a reason for its existence, have caused both institutes to undergo several changes of organisation and name changes, although the essence of their scientific research has persisted.

The IAH of the Slovak Academy of Sciences (from 2018 part of the ARC) focuses on the research of Slovak art and architecture history and its International context. The subject includes research on painting, sculpture, artistic craft and architecture from the Middle Ages to the 21st century, analysis of historical development, international relations, iconographic motifs, social connections and theoretical aspects of art history.

The ITFR of the Slovak Academy of Sciences (from 2018 part of the ARC) focuses on research into the history and theory of theatre, film, radio, television and modern electronic media. Subjects include directing, acting, scenography, drama, theater music, audiovisual technology

not only in an aesthetic framework but also in a social, political, psychological, etc. The most traditional art is theatre, where research goes back to the earliest times of European civilization; the other arts are younger and are pursued scientifically in the 20th and 21st centuries.

All the arts, which were previously studied by two separate institutes, co-create a true Gesamtkunstwerk. Until 2018 the separate IAH and ITFR merged on 1 April 2018 because of the improved ability to examine the subject of research in a broader context and because of the possibility to more easily create interdisciplinary teams in line with the times. The issue of certain economic savings was also not negligible. The wide range of arts that are synthetically investigated by the Art Research Centre of the SAS could and should still be extended to literature and musical arts, but those institutes of SAS that deal with these arts did not join our Centre. So now we have to convince everyone that we have done the right thing.

The Charter of the Art Research Centre states in Article IV (abbreviated):

Article IV

Object of the organisation's activities

(1) The predominant main activity of the organisation shall be to carry out research in the following fields of science and technology: Theory and History of Theatre (060413), Theory and History of Film, Radio and Television (060415), Aesthetics and History of Aesthetics (060405), Theory and History of Visual Arts (060410), Theory and History of Art (060414), Other Related Fields of Cultural Sciences and Arts (060499).

(2) The other main activities of the organisation are:

(a) the provision and management of research and development infrastructure to which the organisation has a property right,

(b) the acquisition, processing and dissemination of information in the field of science and technology and knowledge from its own research and development, in the fields referred to in paragraph (1); the publication of the journal Slovenské divadlo (ISSN 0037-699X) and ARS (ISSN 0044-9008) and other periodical and non-periodical publications,

(c) participation in the implementation of study programmes of the third degree of higher education in cooperation with the universities, namely the study programme in aesthetics in the field of study philosophy and study programmes in the field of study arts and cultural sciences,

(d) cooperation in the field of science and technology with universities, other legal entities carrying out research and development with the private sphere, in the fields referred to in paragraph (1).

Such a wide range of research tasks cannot be covered in a short time by one Centre ARC with two dozen employees. Thus, we have to - as our predecessors had to and those who will come after us will have, to take a very judicious approach, with an awareness of the long-term development perspective, and at the same time, with regard to the current development of science, art and society, to select research topics and to build up our ARC both in terms of personnel and infrastructure.

1.8. Summary of R&D activity pursued by the institute during the evaluation period in both national and international contexts. Describe the scientific importance and societal impact of each important result/discovery. Important results of the ARC (IAH+ITFR) are listed here by the individual institutes (IAH and ITFR) that merged into one Centre in 2018. It is here that the reader can see what were the main research topics of the individual institutes and how some common themes started to be added later. At the same time, we will highlight the most significant results achieved by the ARC in this way.

At the beginning of the questionnaire, as the Director of ARC, I must mention the issue of the national and international context that we find in the terms of this evaluation. It is not a very happily chosen indicator. In the case of our scientific disciplines (theatre, film, visual arts, etc.), such a division is quite deceptive. I will illustrate this with one example: three times in my professional career I have been approached from abroad by authors of dictionaries and encyclopaedias and asked to write entries on Slovak theatre and culture for their encyclopaedias. (The last time was during the creation of a feminist encyclopaedia: Didier, B., Fouque, A., Calle-Gruber, M. *Le Dictionnaire universel des femmes créatrices 1-3.* (Paris : Des Femmes, 2013.) Thus, for the authors of a major international publication, I was interesting because I was able to write entries that focused in depth on Slovak theatre. How would we classify these entries of mine today? Would they be international or would they be of national importance? I think that although they were not dedicated to, say, Shakespeare, but "only" to the actress Anička Jurkovičová, about whom nobody knew anything, they were actually of international significance, because their significance was reflected in the encyclopaedia. They were of international, not national, importance (a potential domestic student would have found enough information about Anička Jurkovičová elsewhere). Moreover, who said that international importance should be a criterion of their quality? What if, in the aforementioned French encyclopaedia, these entries of mine also met with some less well-crafted texts, devoted to, say, the aforementioned Shakespeare, but by authors from big cultures. This should be a criterion, although perhaps their author should go learn how to write good entries from some of the smaller, not so internationally known cultures? Therefore, briefly, right at the outset of this questionnaire, I think that "national" and "international" are not the right evaluative or categorizing and characterizing criteria, and we will prefer to consider everything that has been produced of quality as international, able to stand right next to the best that comes from the land of "international". (Miloslav Mistrík)

In organizing research, ARC forms ad hoc teams composed of scientists and other staff, and possibly external collaborators from other institutions, such as those whose scientific expertise best fits the upcoming research and its objectives, and then, of course, we seek to submit the project for funding by one of the agencies. Thus, even in retrospective, it appears that the main and fundamental lines of research and, as a rule, the best results are associated with the grant tasks that ARC (IAH and ITFR) have addressed (mainly to APVV - Slovak Research and Development Agency) and VEGA (Scientific Grant Agency). Sometimes in the Questionnaire we list the scientific research results of our institutes separately (IAH and ITFR), but most of them, when possible, we already have joint projects and joint results for the whole ARC after 2018.

IAH

The basic form of support for IAH research activities in the evaluated period were individual projects of the VEGA grant agency. Their list can be found at <http://www.dejum.SAS.sk/?language=sk§ion=project>, older projects are in the „Archive“ section. The information is available in both Slovak and English versions. Some of these projects represented teamwork, implemented in synergy between several institutions. The most important results are:

- The project *Basic Concepts of Image Theory in Interdisciplinary Reflection and Art History Practice* (2015-2018), developed in collaboration with the University of Trnava, was addressed by an interdisciplinary team in which, in addition to art historians (P. Megyeši, M. Haľák, B. Hodásová, M. Zervan, and I. Gerát), philosophers, cognitive scientists, and anthropologists also spoke. One of the results of this project is the publication *Algorithms of images - images of algorithms*: the nature of research in contemporary art, where the findings were applied directly to the analysis of the work of selected representatives of contemporary art in Slovakia.
- The project *Iconology of Charity in Central European Cities - the Example of Bratislava* (2019-2022), is socially relevant also because in a methodologically interdisciplinary connection and with the use of analyses of iconology, phenomenology and hermeneutics, it opens up new perspectives in addressing the questions of the significance of charitable monuments for the development of cities in a broader European context as well. The most significant result is the monograph GERÁT, Ivan. *Iconology of Charity : Medieval Legends of Saint Elizabeth in Central Europe*. Leuven; Paris; Bristol : Peeters, 2020, (<https://www.martinus.sk/?ulitem=845993>) which presents the results of research on Central European image cycles of Saint Elizabeth of Hungary. The religious leaders who commissioned these paintings used them for a variety of purposes, from the cultivation of memory and cult, to local politics, to crusading propaganda and the fight against heresy. The book traces the complex events of this interval - from the Order of the Teutonic Knights in Marburg, to the monastic communities of Český Krumlov, to the inhabitants of medieval Košice, one of Europe's most important centres of its cult.

ITFR

Also the basic form of support for ITFR research activities in the evaluated period were projects of the VEGA grant agency. Their list can be found at <http://www.udfv.SAS.sk/?lang=sk&site=projects-cur>.

-One of the most significant results of ITFR's research is the extensive collective publication *Slovak Theatre in the Era of Transformations. Views on Slovak Theatre 1989 - 2015* (2017, ed. E. Knopová, other authors M. Mistrik, A. Maťašík, M. Mojžišová and from the collaborating universities N. Lindovská, M. Ballay). <https://veda.SAS.sk/kniha/knopova-elena-ed-sucasne-slovenske-divadlo-v-dobe-spolecenskych-premien-pohlady-na-slovenske-divadlo-1989-2015> It is the first comprehensive survey of Slovak theatre since the socio-political change in 1989. This publication, although it was followed by other partial historical works on the current state of theatre in Slovakia, has not yet been surpassed and has become a reference work not only for the Slovak professional community, but also for foreign scholars.

- The conference *Theatre as a Value-based Discourse - Slovak Theatre and Contemporary European Theatre Culture* (2017) and the proceedings *Theatre as a Value-based Discourse* (2018, ed. E. Knopová) <https://veda.SAS.sk/kniha/knopova-elena-theatre-as-a-value-based-discourse-slovak-theatre-and-contemporary-european-theatre-culture> (VEGA 2/0170/16 : *Theatre as Communication of the Crisis of Values*) bridged the juxtaposition of international/national, and explored the universal human issues in identifying the values represented but also created by contemporary European theatre, in relation to the newly constituted values of the 21st century. The societal relevance of the output lies mainly in its axiological nature and in the formulation of new impulses for contemporary theatre research, which works with different kinds of values/qualities in close relation to the dynamic transformations of a culturally diversified society and the performing arts, while the cross-comparison of the findings has made it possible to trace the movements in

value orientations in different countries. The discourse was enhanced by the active presence of colleagues from the UK, Spain, France, Germany, Poland and the Czech Republic.

- The bilingual (DE/SK) publication *Max Reinhardt a/und Bratislava/Pressburg* (2018, ed. M. Mistrík), published in collaboration with the Austrian Theatermuseum Wien, <https://veda.SAS.sk/kniha/mistrik-milos-ed-max-reinhardt-a-bratislava-und-pressburg> contributed to the portrait of one of Austria's most important directors, Max Reinhardt, in order to uncover and make accessible a number of hitherto unknown contexts and circumstances of the creative beginnings of one of the most important directors of the 20th century, who influenced theatrical aesthetics, acting techniques, and thinking about the theatre. (The project APVV-15-0764: Slovak theater and contemporary European theater culture - continuity and discontinuity). The forgotten circumstances of Reinhardt's work in the cultural environment of Bratislava and his family connection with the town of Stupava have been disseminated into the established European scholarly discourse through prominent experts from Austria, Germany, France and Slovakia, authors of the book. The social impact of this research activity is best documented by the interest of the scientific community, but also by the support and partnership of the Austrian Cultural Forum, the non-profit organization JEWROPE, and participating of ambassadors of Austria, the Federal Republic of Germany and Israel. It also included close cooperation with the town of Stupava, thanks to which the adjacent area of the local synagogue was named Max Reinhardt Square.

IAH and ITFR together:

- The project APVV-15-0526 : The theme of the Three Kings in the art of Slovakia - interdisciplinary studies of cultural tradition and communication. The work of the whole team has led to the publication of several articles in prestigious journals (e.g. Burlington magazine, Umění) as well as to the publication of an edited book, *The Theme of the Three Kings in Art and Culture* (Bratislava: VEDA, 2021 <https://veda.SAS.sk/kniha/gerat-ivan-ed-tema-troch-kralov-v-umeni-a-v-kulture>), which offers a comprehensive view of the Christmas motif of the Adoration of the Three Kings and its depiction in various artistic media in a broad sweep from biblical times to the present day. Readers can gain an overview of the history of the theme, its different meanings and functions, its origins and the transformations of its visual, musical and theatrical canon, including an overview of its impact on society in different historical situations.

- The interdisciplinary project APVV-19-0522 *Creating and Critiquing Value in Contemporary Art (Visual Arts, Theatre, Film)* has been supported for 2019-2023, based on the idea that value creation in contemporary art is related to the search for ways out of cultural and social crises, proposing alternative solutions and testing their possibilities. In contemporary art, the project aims to name, define and further explore systems of value in a free society in the context of the conditions of neoliberal capitalism. The critical investigation focuses on the question of how art disrupts or restores traditional or otherwise established values in relation to the individual's responsibility towards society and the world, culture and history. What or who is the arbiter of these values, and how do the values produced by contemporary art relate to the issues of today's world (migration, climate change, the ethics of truth)? One of the first results is now the monograph of Miloš Mistrík: *Rhythmics. Hellerau and Jaques-Dalcroze*. Bratislava : VEDA, 2021. <https://veda.SAS.sk/kniha/mistrik-milos-rytmika-hellerau-a-jacques-dalcroze>

- one of ARC's most important international projects:

Project MOCAHIC - Charles IV. as a collector (2018 - 2023), was supported under the Horizon 2020 program. Its researcher Ingrid Ciulísová focuses on collecting the Middle Ages in Western and Central Europe, especially at the court of the Roman emperor and Czech King Charles IV (1316-1378). A comprehensive analysis of the art objects that this monarch acquired, or the execution of which he directly ordered, aims at the research of power strategies, of which these objects were an integral part, as well as at their role, which they played as symbols of ruling legitimacy. The project is designed interdisciplinary and transnational. The use of a wide range of methods and procedures from the history of art, history, auxiliary historical sciences, mineralogy, anthropology, classical studies and studies of material culture is expected.

2.1.8. Narrative on the most important research outputs of the institute – especially focused on their importance for society (3-5 pages)

As noted above, the founding charter gives our ARC more tasks than we could possibly accomplish in one time. Therefore, our research is always focused on selected portions that either (1) continuously extend previous research or (2) go into unexplored areas.

(1) Continuous research extends and complements the knowledge gained by our researches over several years or decades before, and by doing so we create a comprehensive body of knowledge about particular kinds of art. For example, it continuously builds and completes the overall picture of the development of visual arts in Slovakia from the Gothic period to the end of the 19th century. Or in the field of theatre, a comprehensive historical picture of the development of Slovak theatre in its individual components (directing, acting, scenography, drama, music) is being built up.

(2) New researches in unexplored areas do not so much take into account historical continuity, but are focused on new areas, emerging from the movements of society and art, often experimental or avant-garde. On the basis of the above, the results of ARC's research can be divided into four headings, which correspond to the social order. It is the research of visual arts and architecture from the Gothic period to the end of the 19th century and the research of modern artistic movements in the 20th and 21st centuries, then the third and fourth circle is based on the performing arts - in its scientific outputs ARC focuses mainly on the history of Slovak theatre in the last hundred years and on the history of film.

For research on older art, the ARC has the best-established structures - personnel, databases, organisational structures - and has been doing continuous research since the establishment of this workplace in the Slovak Academy of Sciences, published in dozens of historical monographs and a large number of studies published in renowned foreign and domestic periodicals. This research is also provided by the Institute's journal ARS. It confirms the high artistic value of artifacts originating from our territory, their territorial specificity, as well as international links within the Central European area (Austria, Hungary, Czech Republic, Poland with overlap to Germany and the Mediterranean area). ARC has a sufficiently broad team of experts for this research (J. Bakos, I. Ciulísová, I. Gerát, B. Hodášová (Balážová), B. Pomfyová, V. Kucharská, and gradually younger researchers and PhD students (P. Megyesi) are coming in. A smaller part of the staff is mainly devoted to newer art (Z. Bartošová, D. Bořutová, I. Gerát, M. Zervan, D. Grúň.)

In the performing arts, theatre research has traditionally been better staffed (M. Mistrík, E. Knopová, D. Podmaková, M. Mojžišová, Z. Timčíková, K. Mišovic). As the past period was marked by the celebration of the 100th anniversary of the Slovak National Theatre (1920), a large part of the research was devoted to this and a number of scientific publications, journal studies, conferences, as well as popularization contributions on radio and television were produced. In the field of film and television research, the ARC has only two staff members, J. Dudková and M. Palúch (sometimes also PhD students). For this reason, their goal cannot be large collective monographs, because this area of research is poorly saturated not only in our Centre, but also in other research institutes and universities in general in Slovakia.

The disadvantage turns into an advantage in the possibility of adapting research more closely to current topics, as they are dynamically brought by the Slovak and world film and as they are brought by dramatic socio-political changes. Thus J. Dudková has repeatedly dealt with war conflicts in Europe (ex-Yugoslavia), M. Palúch with documentary film. In it, truthfulness and manipulation, various forms of censorship, which are not only a historical matter.

The essential thing that we take special care of is that these narrowly defined focuses are also chosen to meet the social order and the current needs of society. It should be noted that in the structure of institutions in the Slovak Republic that are focused on reflection on art, our Art Research Centre of the Slovak Academy of Sciences forms a specific part that has no equivalent elsewhere. In short, there are universities and colleges in which, of course, the research component is also represented, but these are workplaces with the task of primarily educating students of the three cycles. By comparison, our ARC also has the task of educating, but only in

the third cycle (PhD). Apart from pedagogical, there are also other related institutions in Slovakia, for example museums, galleries, theatres and cultural centres, a film institute, a theatre institute, but needless to say, their main task, apart from the partly scientific work, is focused elsewhere. Our ARC is a place of knowledge production, not knowledge recycling, so we are focused on basic, original research, not its popularisation. Although, let's say that we also exist as an Institute providing services to state and public institutions, mainly on an individual basis, depending on what kind of specialist or expert is requested by the institutions for expertise, opinions, participation in advisory bodies, etc.

Through individual participation, we come into contact with the public, for example through television, radio, the press and nowadays the Internet, FB (<https://www.facebook.com/udfvsav>), and respond to the requests of the aforementioned state and service institutions in our field. This part of the activity is a natural part of our overall activity directly in social orders, but it must not go beyond the essential component of our work in basic, original research.

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2.5.8. Supplementary information and/or comments on doctoral studies and educational activities – focused on what changes have occurred since the last evaluation in 2016

Doctoral studies are governed by the internal regulation of the ARC "System of evaluation of the quality of doctoral studies at the ARC". The regulation reflects the long-term vision of the development of doctoral studies, which aims at the comprehensive preparation of future researchers, applicable in SAS as well as other scientific, possibly also artistic research institutions, universities, etc. in Slovakia and abroad.

All PhD students are involved in grant tasks under the supervision of supervisors and show continuous publication and conference activity. In addition, doctoral students undergo teaching activities in the form of invited lectures at related universities (VŠMU, AU, TU). They have set quantitative indicators: to prepare their own scientific seminar once a year, to publish a total of at least two scientific papers in journals or conference proceedings per year, to give at least one presentation at a conference or professional event, to prepare their own seminar once a year in the framework of ARC seminars.

Important internal criteria of a training institute are:

(a) publication of at least 1 scientific study registered in professional databases, or in journals with IF ≥ 0.14 , or a work of fundamental importance published in a world language, or in a foreign publishing house;

b) completion of a foreign research internship/mobility.

ARC fully supports PhD students in their growth and progress, assisting them in facilitating contacts with foreign countries, in obtaining scholarships and securing foreign study stays, as well as in improving their manuscripts and methodology. In the accreditation period under review, all PhD students managed to fulfil the conditions set / we did not have a single unsuccessful PhD student.

Since the last accreditation, a system of regular semester-long doctoral colloquia has been introduced at the ARC. All PhD students and supervisors, the PhD supervisor and other researchers are present at the colloquia. If necessary, external experts in the field are also invited. Doctoral students and supervisors, on the basis of previously sent documents and written theses, present the results of doctoral research and scientific work to all ARC researchers during the colloquia and evaluate the current status of the dissertation. The scientific community comments on the quality of the achieved results, training and proposes recommendations for improving the course of study and the fulfilment of the required outcome criteria.

Case Study 1 (Ivan Gerát)

Cooperation with NOVUM Foundation

1. Organizing a competition of art projects in the field of visual arts

The IAH of SAS continues its contractual cooperation with the NOVUM Foundation (nadacianovum.sk), on the basis of which the portfolios of the participants of the competition of Slovak visual artists, organized by the Foundation, are regularly included in the Institute's documentation database. In the period under review, six editions of the competition were held, during which the portfolios of more than a hundred relevant artists (some of whom entered the competition repeatedly) were professionally evaluated, each of whom had to have at least three solo exhibitions in established institutions. Each artist entered the competition with a project. The winning projects are awarded €30,000 each year. The very existence of the competition thus inspires artistic creation and its dialogue with the international professional community, as in each edition internationally renowned art historians not only from the V4 countries, but also from major institutions in Western Europe and the USA, draw up judgements. Ivan Gerát and Marian Zervan also participate in these activities as members of the Foundation's Board of Trustees.

2. Organizing symposia on current topics in contemporary art and publishing their results in books

Ivan Gerát and Marian Zervan have been organizers of interdisciplinary symposia with international participation, which are always accompanied by thematic exhibitions of the works of the artists awarded in the NOVUM Foundation competition. These events become the basis for the preparation of book publications that combine the genre of exhibition catalogue and conference proceedings in an innovative way. Studies of a scientific nature are complemented by professional and essayistic texts, as well as high-quality reproductions of works by the exhibiting artists. Thematically, the books address current issues of dialogue between the technosphere, represented primarily by the tumultuous development of computer technology (including image processing and editing programs), and the sphere of art, which combines sensitive creative responses to changes in the experiential world of the contemporary with reflection on the deeper traditions that bind contemporary artistic creation to its historical roots.

The first of these conferences was devoted to the theme Algorithms of Images - Images of Algorithms. On the problem of art in the present (in collaboration with the Academy of Fine Arts). The conference was accompanied by an exhibition of the same name, held in collaboration with the Novum Foundation at the Medium Gallery. Ivan Gerát and Marian Zervan were the curators of this exhibition, the specificity of which was the participation of relevant authors - finalists of the competition, selected in two rounds of international evaluation with the assistance of international experts. Each of the selected authors opened a specific dimension of the relationship between algorithms and images. Both the exhibition and the conference resulted in the collective monograph Algorithms of Images - Images of Algorithms; The Nature of Research in Contemporary Art. Ivan Gerát and Marian Zervan are the editors and authors of the introductory study in this monograph, which is the first publication devoted to this topical subject of contemporary art in the Slovak language. Among other Institute staff, Peter Megyeši also contributed to the publication.

In 2019, a conference and an exhibition on the topic of Operational and External Memory in Art. Its social activity consisted, among other things, in confronting artistic strategies in the approach to historical memory with technocratic conceptions of memory media. The exhibition External and Operational Memory focused on the use of different kinds of archived data or long-term stored memory

outside and within art, the use of storage, changing media and the possibilities of ROM and RAM of currently running programs, virtual disks and their erasures and refreshes, but also on their analogies in the polarities of the geological and the organic, cultural and technological, semantic and episodic memory, long-term or short-term memory, sedimented mediated and procedural memory, various kinds of amnesia, erasure, displacement, anamnesis and recollection, heteronomous and autonomous memory, memory of culture and art, and memory of genres and their unrepeatable modifications. External and Operational Memory discusses the diverse kinds of memory that contemporary art works with: semantic and episodic memory, long-term or short-term memory, sedimented spaced and procedural memory, as well as different kinds of amnesias, erasures, anamnesias and recollections, heteronomous and autonomous

The following year, the series of events continued with a conference and exhibition entitled Illusion and Virtual Reality in the Arts, which, due to pandemic constraints, was held on the MS Teams platform.

The exhibition of the same name, this time without an opening, was made available at the Medium Gallery and curated by Dr. Miroslav Haľák (Belvedere Vienna). Ivan Gerát and Marian Zervan were the editors of the publication Illusion and Virtual Reality in Art (its scientific editors were Adam Bžoch, Miroslav Marcelli and Michal Šedík). The book was published in cooperation between the NOVUM Foundation, the Centre for Art Sciences of the Academy of Sciences of the Slovak Academy of Sciences, the Academy of Fine Arts and the Slovart publishing house.

Case Study 2 (Miloš Mistrík)

Research as a Contribution to International Understanding.

Max Reinhardt (1873-1943) was one of the most important avant-garde theatre directors of the 20th century. His ancestors, the Goldmann family, came from Stupava, a small town in the suburbs of Bratislava (then Pressburg). He was born in Baden near Vienna, lived in Austria and Germany, and emigrated to the U.S. before the Nazis, where he died.

Some periods of his life are connected to Bratislava. His relatives lived here, he performed as an actor at the Arena summer theatre here in 1893, his divorce trial took place here, and it was here that he finally applied for Czechoslovak citizenship while on the run from Hitler. All these episodes of his life have been forgotten until now, even by the professional public.

Underpinning research; References to the research: We have therefore said that it is the task of Slovak theatre studies to summarise the image of Reinhardt in relation to Bratislava. And so in 2018 we organised an international scientific conference *Max Reinhardt and Bratislava*, where, in addition to Slovak historians, experts from Austria, Germany and France also spoke.

Details of the impact 1: Following an agreement with the mayor of Stupava, Roman Maroš, we opened the conference in the local partially restored synagogue and combined it with a ceremony naming the space next to the synagogue the Max Reinhardt Square.

We invited a number of personalities. What was our surprise when ambassadors from three countries came to Stupava: Austria, Germany and Israel, all of whom wanted to give speeches. Although we do not measure the success of scientific conferences by the number of ambassadors attending, we considered it an extraordinary moment in which the history of theatre was combined with a topical message of international understanding. The photographs capture that special day (**sources to corroborate the impact**).



After this success, we decided to write a collective monograph. Thus, thanks to the cooperation with the Vienna Theatermuseum and the Bratislava publishing house VEDA, a bilingual Slovak/German book *Max Reinhardt a/und Bratislava/Pressburg* was published with an international team of authors.

The book is selling well, reviews have already been published, one of them written in Berlin by none other than Klaus Völker. (VÖLKER, K. Herr von Flott. In *Theater heute*, 2020, vol. 61, No. 11, p. 63. ISSN 0040-5507)

But the story does not end there. **Details of the impact 2:** When the then Austrian Chancellor Sebastian Kurz visited Slovakia in 2021, a press conference was organised at a symbolic place, in front of the Arena Theatre. The director and actor of this theatre, Juraj Kukura, welcomed the heads of the two neighbouring countries, Slovakia and Austria, with a small gift - he presented them both with a copy of our book (we, the authors of this book, only found out about it later). It's

nice to see the photos (**sources to corroborate the impact**) of this act, at the moment when Chancellor Kurz forgets official protocol for a moment and reads the book he is holding in his hands, while Slovak Prime Minister Heger is talking to the director of the theatre.

Summary of the impact: We consider both of these essentially accidental moments to be the best evidence of how our scientific research has also achieved a wider and positive social and political significance.

Case Study 3 (Elena Knopová)

Theatre lectures within the theatre education project Psota na Slovensku [Misery in Slovakia] (2019 - 2022)

Misery in Slovakia is an educational project for high school and university students focused on migration, radicalisation and xenophobia (towards foreigners): information available at <https://poton.sk/psota-na-slovensku/> and <https://poton.sk/english-summary/>.

These are day-long events that bring together artists, researchers, experts and activists from different institutions and social fields. The structure of the project is multidimensional - theatre performance, interactive theatre lectures, creative workshops, expert discussions, a living library and lectures on third sector organisations.

E. Knopová's lectures focused on the analysis of the stage production The Emperor of America, based on Martin Pollack's reportage novel (<https://poton.sk/americky-cisar/>). It depicted the mass emigration from the multicultural and poverty-stricken region of Galicia at the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries. By comparing the fates of our ancestors (Poles, Ukrainians, Ruthenians and Slovaks; both Christians and Jews) with the current European refugee crisis, lecturer E. Knopová focused on issues of identity, home, poverty, economic migration, the "stranger" as a commodity, the feeling of threat to the majority leading to extremist attitudes towards minorities, the creation of conspiratorial political rhetoric, but also constructing a dream in the image of a better life somewhere else.

The aim of the project was to stimulate a professional discussion with young people on the topic of migration, attitudes towards foreigners in Slovakia and the cultivation of independent critical thinking in an experiential way.

The project was preceded by years of research by E. Knopová, thanks to which ITFR participated in several joint activities with Pôtoň Theatre:

Within the framework of Misery in Slovakia 2019 - 2022, 20 editions of this project were realized, theatre lectures, which were positively evaluated by students, and other activities were attended by 824 students and 50 teachers from 18 secondary schools and universities outside of Bratislava, both live and in lockdown online.

One of the aims of the project was to conduct sociological research on the impact of the project on students as participants in the event - before and after the activities. The research focused on the perception of migration and the attitudes of young people towards foreigners. The research showed that students' knowledge about cultural diversity, about migration and foreigners living in Slovakia, about state policies regarding migration increased significantly after the project (59.4% of students answered that the event definitely contributed to the increase in knowledge and 24.9% that it contributed rather). There was also a shift in their perception of this issue, from negative settings to a more analytical perception and a perception of migration in a broader social, cultural and economic context. Another finding was that learning activities are much more effective when they are delivered live than online, which is particularly relevant for Slovak universities that want to deliver theoretical courses at a distance. Events such as Misery in Slovakia have the potential to reach and engage young people in an attractive way on issues that have a very negative charge in public or political discourse and the potential to promote many stereotypes or portray migration as a threat. It turns out that such events, which combine expertise with art and learning about the real experiences of foreigners, are able to bring the topic to young people in an interesting and understandable way and to some extent shape their attitudes.

The project Misery in Slovakia 2019 - 2022 has been supported by the Active citizens fund Slovakia programme, which is funded by the EEA and Norway Grants Financial Mechanism 2014 - 2021. The programme administrator is the Open Society Foundation.

In the field of arts studies, there are generally minimal, governmental, international or other commissions from the public, private and commercial sectors. If this sphere of commissioners of research does not turn to art studies institutes it is also because the relationship in question does exist, but it takes place mainly at the individual level. Institutions choose individual experts, specialists, members of their boards and advisory councils on individual tasks, but not the entire institutes in which these experts are working. The situation is diametrically opposed to that of some other institutes, such as medical and pharmaceutical institutes, technical institutes, even sociological institutes, for example - these institutes are approached by government institutions for scientific cooperation, asking for help on complex problems (e.g. currently COVID-19).

Therefore, institutions dedicated to scientific research in the arts will usually themselves request the opportunity to contribute to the social good through their work. This is mainly in the form of project proposals, grant applications. If successful, they then obtain external funding and in return guarantee the delivery of the results of the contracted project (e.g. in the form of publications, public scientific events, etc.). Our ARC and its employees have been successful for a long time in applications for such research funding. As this report shows, we have already received several grants from VEGA, APVV, as well as from the Literary Fund, the Fund for the Support of the Arts, and the Audiovisual Fund. The way it happens between the two parties can be secondary in such cases - whether you are approached by a public and private institution with a particular need, or you approach them with an offer of help to address the same need - is, after all, almost similar. The scientist gives his scientific capacity to the institution with which he has contracted, and is rewarded by that institution. Both ways of contacting and collaborating can work, but some questionnaires are recording and accepting only one of them.

2.8. Background and management. Infrastructure and human resources, incl. support and incentives for young researchers

The rules of a public research institution, set by law and regulations, require that the ARC have one Director General and that each of the two branches also have a Director. All three are elected by a committee of the Presidium of the SAS, so the Director General does not choose the director, nor can he dismiss them. This is not a correct principle and can create difficult problems if disharmony arises in this trinity

Fortunately, no leadership problems have arisen in ARC; the trio of directors do their work efficiently and can respond flexibly to the needs of the day. The Director General is Miloš Mistrík, the IAH Director is Ivan Gerát and the ITFR Director is Elena Knopová. Various other functions are cumulated in ARC, mainly in the economic, personnel and operational areas. The ARC has two libraries, according to the previous composition, and there are no plans to merge them yet. The following tables show the statistics of the staff composition of the ARC.

In terms of age, the majority of the staff is between 30 and 50 years old, from whom we can already expect mature scientific personalities. At the moment we do not have staff under 30, so there is no need to look for any special support activities in terms of age. Of course, we take special care of PhD students, which is not difficult in such a relatively small institut where the staff are sufficiently familiar with their activities and willing to help at any time.

The ARC has a Board of Directors (7 members), a Scientific Council (7) and a Supervisory Board (3). We have two elected representatives in the SAS Senate and two elected staff representatives. We do not see any major problems with employment issues at the moment.

3. Implementation of the recommendations from the previous evaluation period

At the last evaluation in 2012-2015, the IAM and ITFR institutes were still separate and therefore received different recommendations.

ITFR

The recommendations of the international panel of experts in 2012-2015 suggested the development of closer cooperation with other institutes of the Slovak Academy of Sciences. This was one of the main reasons that ITFR joined the Open Academy project in the framework of the research programme "Who are we and why?", which aimed at joint cross-cutting research themes of humanities-oriented institutes of the SAS (available at: <http://otvorenaakademia.SAS.sk/vyskumne-programy/aki-sme-a-preco/zakladne-informacie/>).

A major step towards a closer linking of research within the SAS was the merger of our two institutes in 2018 into the SAS Centre for Arts Sciences. In the short time since the merger of these institutes, new collaborative projects in the visual and performing arts have been established at the ARC.

One of the main recommendations was to further develop the already numerous internationalised projects. Among the results, let us mention in particular The Network of the Musical Theatre Companies in the Multilingual East-Central Europe (Visegrad Grants), linking the Institute of Musicology of the MTA in Budapest, the Department of Musicology of the Palacký University in Olomouc and the Institute of Musicology of the Jagiellonian University in Krakow. Furthermore, a good cooperation with the Historical Institute of the Slovak Academy of Sciences has developed (networking through the VEGA (Scientific Grant Agency) projects "Poetics of Contemporary Performing Arts" and IVF "Towards a common regional history of our nation building strategies. Traveling directors, musicians") or networking within the European Network for Cinema and Media Studies.

Theatre research has become much more oriented towards European or foreign personalities and trends than before (A. Appia, B. Brecht, R. Castellucci, E. Jaques-Dalcroze, P. Konwitschny, M. Reinhardt, V. Vysotsky), on the relationship between performance art and performing arts (the ideological foundations of M. Rau, the actionism of Ch. Schlingensief, social sculpture by J. Beuys,

foreign productions in the field of performance art - contemporary Belgian or Polish scene), on theoretical and broader transdisciplinary oriented themes (compositional and decompositional theatrical principles, issues of diverse identities, inclusive aspects of theatre, representation of changed values, or crisis of values, cultural policies in the field of independent theatre), on socio-cultural and political aspects reflected in theatrical productions and activities. In addition to institutional production and distribution relations in the environment of so-called small cinemas, film research has also expanded to include censorship in the film industry and approaches from the perspectives of post-socialism, post-totalitarianism and post-colonial studies, the construction of deceptive narratives, the problem of the concept of the auteur as Self, Japanese and Slovak auteur documentary film, and the recontextualization of archival film materials as a tool for new research on the history of culture and society (G. Deutsch). From the methodological point of view, it was also about the use of applied anthropology. There was a multi-year cooperation in the field of media studies with the Faculty of Mass Media Communication of the UCM in Trnava on the project Megatrends and Media. The above-mentioned focus has brought several opportunities for publishing abroad or organising international events with the invitation of respected research institutes (e.g. University Institute of France, Université Sorbonne Nouvelle - Paris 3, Université Paris Nanterre, Universita la Sapienza di Roma, University of Barcelona, Universytet ślaski Katowice, University of Vienna, DAMU Praha).

Also on the basis of the recommendations from 2012-2015, we have significantly internationalized our publication platforms, especially in our journal Slovenské divadlo (Slovak Theatre). This integrates one English issue among the other three Slovak issues in the regular periodicity of the journal. Compared to the previous period, the number of peer-reviewed publications in English (but not only in English) has significantly increased - in journals and proceedings registered in the WoS, SCOPUS databases. On the basis of cooperation with invited foreign colleagues we published four collective monographs in English and German. In addition, we have organised international conferences, which have had excellent responses (Theatre as a Discourse of Values, Theatre and Drama in the Contexts of Restless Europe, Max Reinhardt and Bratislava). We have now started to prepare a new ERC Grant with colleagues from the Universität Leipzig, Institut für Theaterwissenschaft.

The international mobility of PhD students and postdocs has been two-way: all ITFR PhD students have completed long-term research fellowships abroad (Austria, Poland, Japan, Czech Republic, RF). As host institutions, we received postdocs and researchers from Greece and Mexico for long-term research stays.

In this way, we have responded to virtually all of the suggestions from the previous accreditation 2012-2015, and the ARC staff has made a purposeful effort to ensure that, having learned lessons in this way as well, they will be able to move up in the 2016-2021 evaluation.

IAH

The International Panel of Experts rated the research activities of the Institute of Art History with a grade of C+ (with an overall grade of B), with the panelists highlighting the Institute's involvement in international research projects. This is a direction that we will continue to support.

Another conclusion of the accreditation is the call to increase the publication of results in world languages, especially in English. This objective has been achieved (see bibliography). In order to achieve this goal, we support research programmes capable of generating such outputs, as well as the finalisation of the outputs themselves. The optimal direction to arouse the interest of the international community is the application of current methodological trends in the discipline in the context of a specific dataset, linked to Central Europe and Slovakia.

In accordance with the recommendations of international accreditation, IAH has also succeeded in achieving accreditation of its third-level study programme.

As part of the development of international cooperation, we strive to provide long-term internships for PhD students at top international workplaces, or to recruit graduates of foreign study programmes to study in our country (for example, our PhD student Katarína Orvinská has completed her Master's studies in Brno and will be a scholarship holder at the Austrian Academy of Sciences in the winter semester 2022/23).

4. Research strategy and future development of the institute for the next five years

Research strategy of the institute in the national and international contexts, objectives, and methods (including the information on when the strategy was adopted)

1. We know that our ARC generally has the best and most numerous results in certain defined areas: in particular, in research on older art and architecture from the Gothic to the Baroque. This is present in many places in Slovakia that have a rich history. Especially the region such as the Central Slovak mining towns where gold, silver and copper were mined (Banská Štiavnica, Kremnica, Banská Bystrica) was rich enough to encourage the creation or purchase of important works of art and the construction of sacred buildings, as well as profane buildings, where artists from Italy or Germany were invited. The Spiš region is also rich in monuments, with influences from Germany and Poland, but also other Slovak regions (Gemer, Bratislava, etc.). We consider the processing of this heritage not only for Slovak needs, but also for the history of Hungary and for a large part of Europe to be a long-term and important research task for the ARC. Even decades have not been enough for us to have everything sufficiently analysed, documented and processed in cooperation with foreign colleagues, which is all the more insistent because in recent decades the identity of a common Europe as an advanced civilisation in which everyone has his place and his role - for example, also in the processing of art history - has been building up. This Slovak and European role in turn determines the direction of further development and is one of the priorities of the main direction of research.
2. Other main priorities are: A/ Slovak professional theatre from the beginning of the 20th century to the present day, B/ Continuity and discontinuity of Slovak theatre with European theatre, i.e. research of exceptional phenomena in Europe (we have already done a lot of research - e.g. A. Appia, J. Copeau, E. Jaques-Dalcroze, K. Stanislavski, J. Grotowski, etc.) and their confrontation with domestic reality. C/ Following the latest developments in avant-garde, performance, new live forms connected with video, digitalisation of image and sound. The permanent and priority task thus constructed is an important new development in the traditionally rather historiographical ARC. These strands of theatre research are a priority for two reasons. The first is understandable because we are the only scholarly centre in the country for theatre research. But there is also an internal reason - theatre as a fleeting and unstable art needs immediate reflection, because unlike, say, literature, after some time we can only encounter it in archives and decayed imprints (mask, costume), the rest is taken away by time.
3. On the face of it, these two basic research areas and priorities are far apart, but on the other hand, other themes are forming around them, converging and pointing to other directions that this ARC is pursuing, or should pursue even more in the future. A/ These can be historical topics such as the question of property relations, subsidies, donors, powerful authorities needing to confirm their priority position (kings - e.g. Charles IV, noble families, wealthy bourgeoisie, the relationship of the state). B/ But there are also very contemporary themes here, blending research into new times and new aesthetic-philosophical value issues of the 21st century. At present, it is as if theatre is receding into the background in its full social reach, but the empty spaces are successfully filled by film and television art, consumed on a daily basis (audience research!), and the post-theatre space opens up the possibility of shifting the audience's attention to the latest digital creative expressions, and to virtual artistic artefacts. Following the latest trends in art, and

researching them scientifically, is not a new topic for ARC's activities, but if we put this in the context of research on older art, we gain extraordinary insight and the ability to better understand the current state of affairs, and even to see into the near future when conceiving newer philosophical and aesthetic concepts

4. All of the above-mentioned research themes will be developed at the ARC with an emphasis on the basic orientation of the staff and group themes that are ad hoc assembled when designing various grant tasks, especially in the environment of APVV (Slovak Research and Development Agency) and VEGA (Scientific Grant Agency) agencies.
5. In order to publish the results, we paid a lot of attention to two ARC journals (Slovenské divadlo and ARS). The former started to publish one (always the third) of its four annual issues in English. We achieved its inclusion in international databases (SCOPUS, QI.), and thus we understandably gained an increased number of people interested in publishing. The journal ARS was threatened with extinction due to underfunding, but we managed to stabilize it and so far we have achieved its periodicity of 2 times a year, and we are also going to penetrate international databases with it - needless to say that all this remains an even more absolute priority for the future.
6. In the past years we have managed to stabilize doctoral studies in cooperation with the universities of Nitra and Trnava and we have successfully graduated doctoral students. The themes of their dissertations are sometimes based on established themes of our Centre, but they are often accompanied by completely new themes, surprising with their views on the artistic and social environment. To this must be added the general interest of the ARC management to rejuvenate the staff by engaging the best PhD students, as well as the gradual departure of older colleagues - we have said goodbye to three in the last period.
7. The last, perhaps smaller, priority is to upgrade and renovate the technical equipment of the department and to provide a high quality on-line connection for the staff, which has proved in recent years to be quite important as a basic solution in case of major conflict situations (e.g. pandemics or power conflicts).
