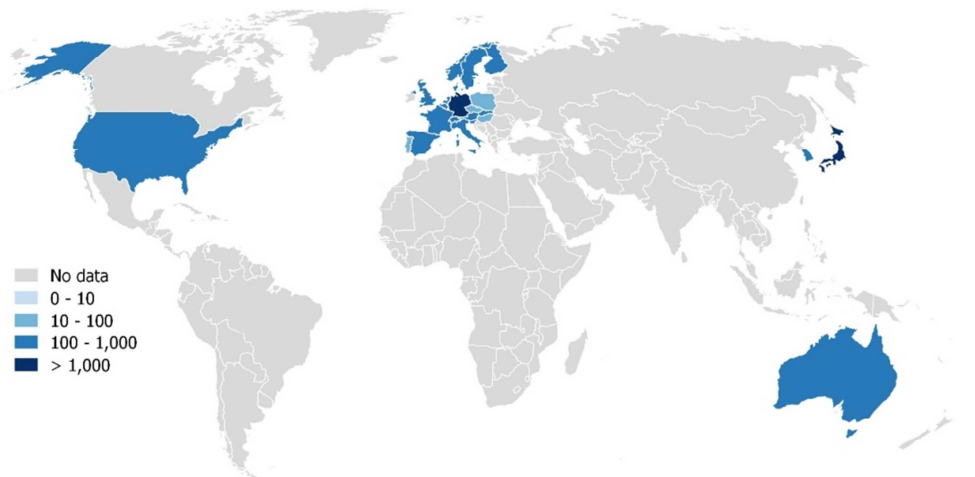


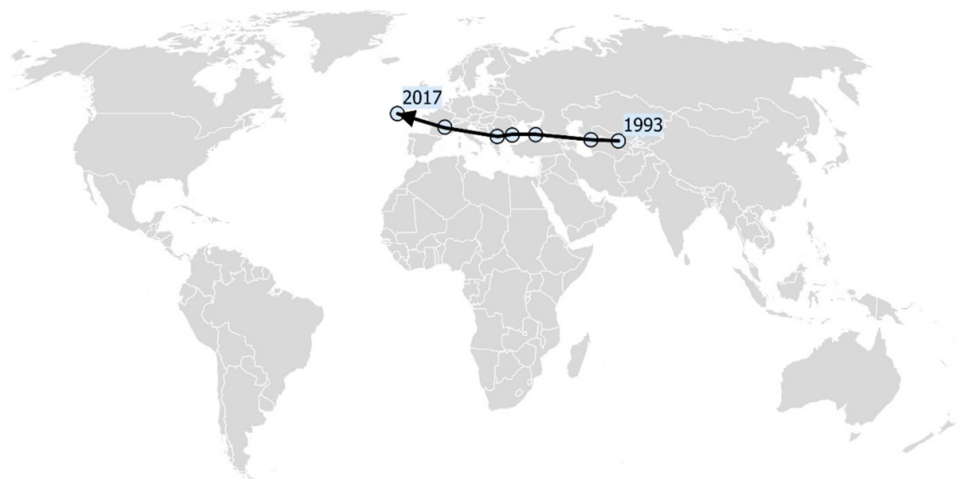

Number of Industrial Robots per Million Economically Active Persons (1993)



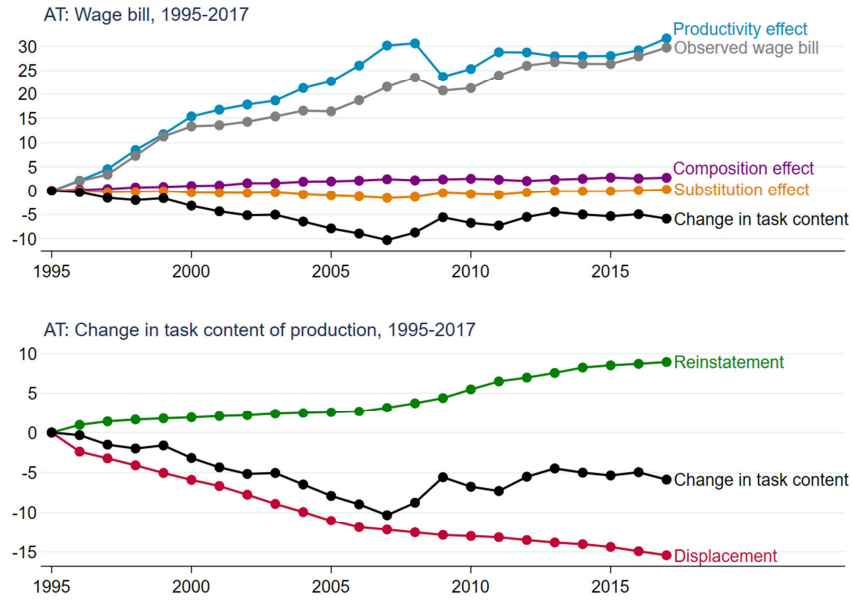

Geographic Center (Centroid) of Industrial Robots' Implementation Over Time



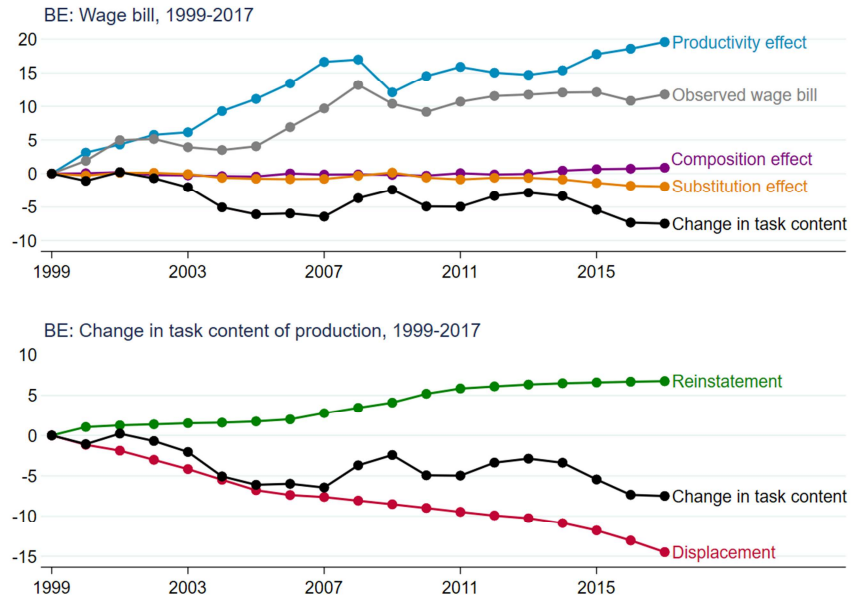

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Austria)



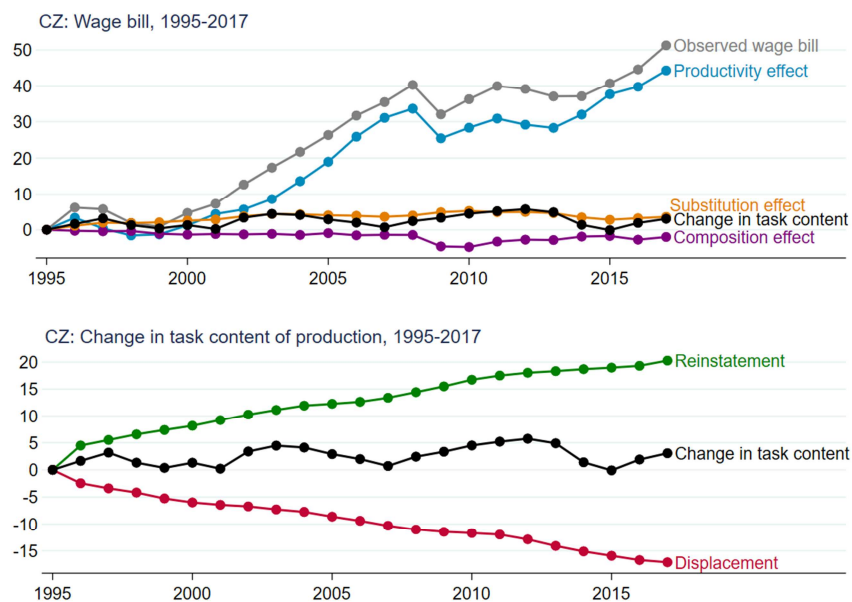

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Belgium)



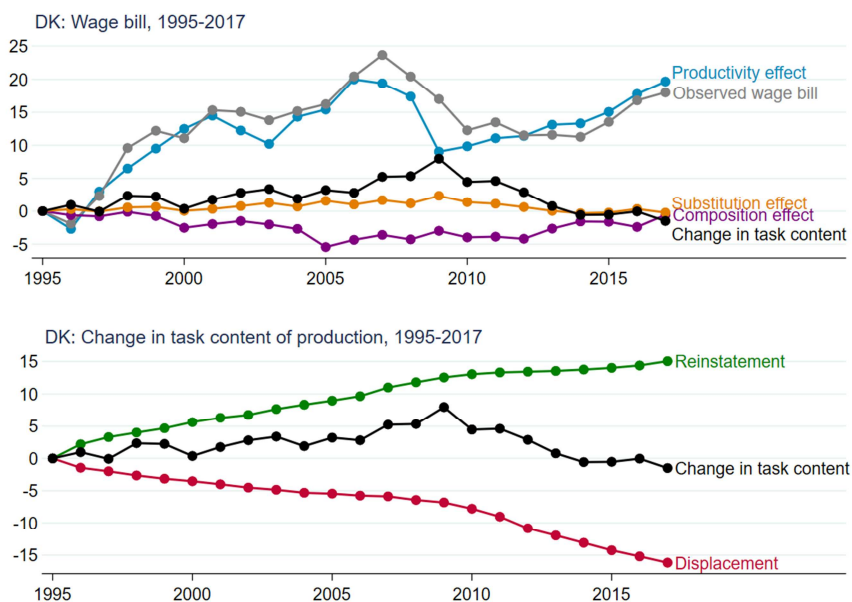

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Czech Republic)



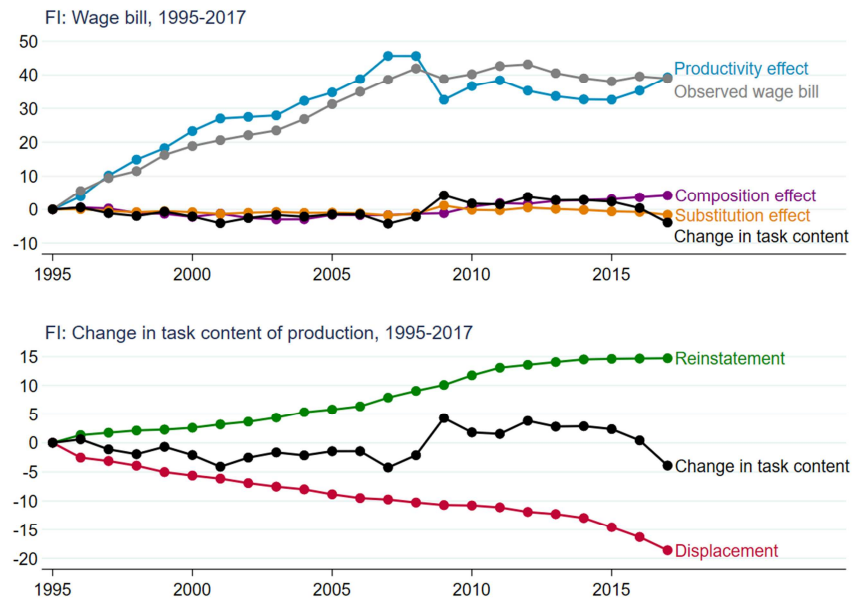

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Denmark)



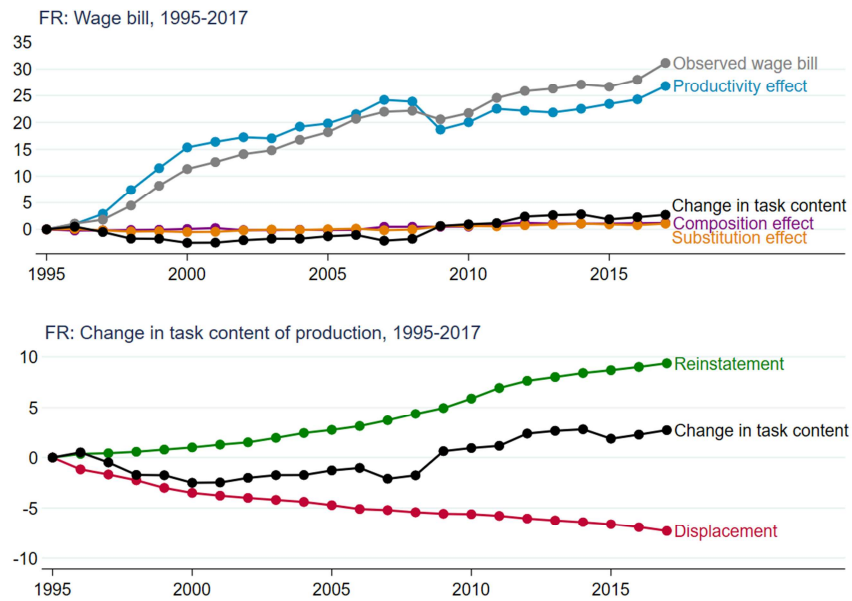

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Finland)



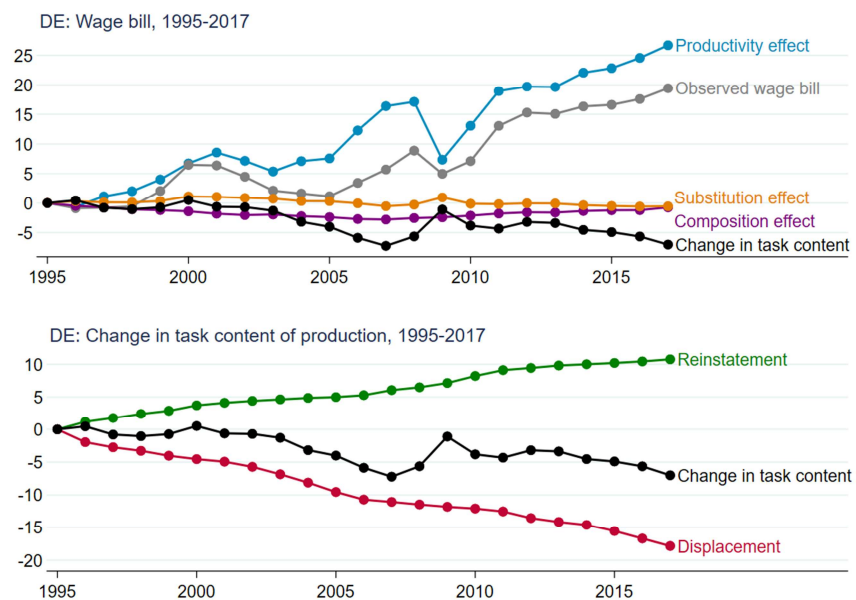

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (France)



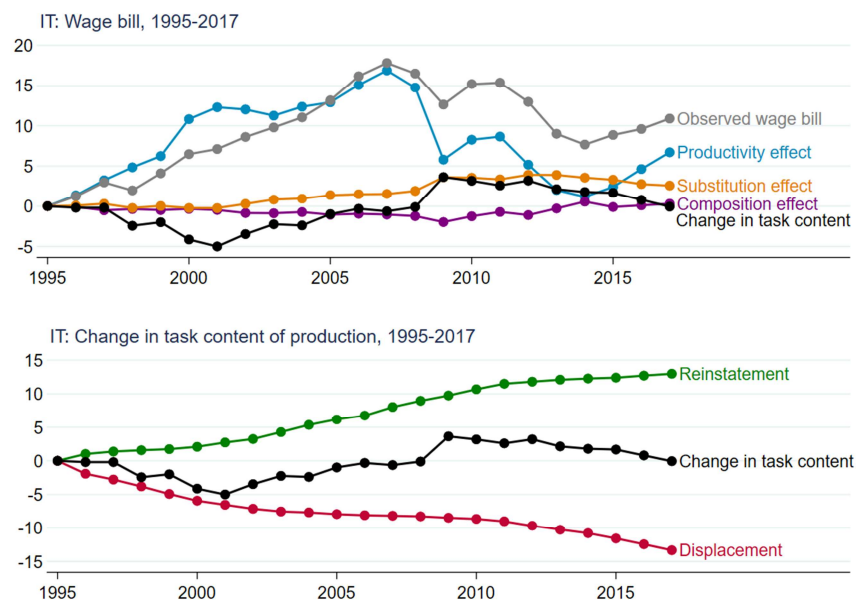

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Germany)



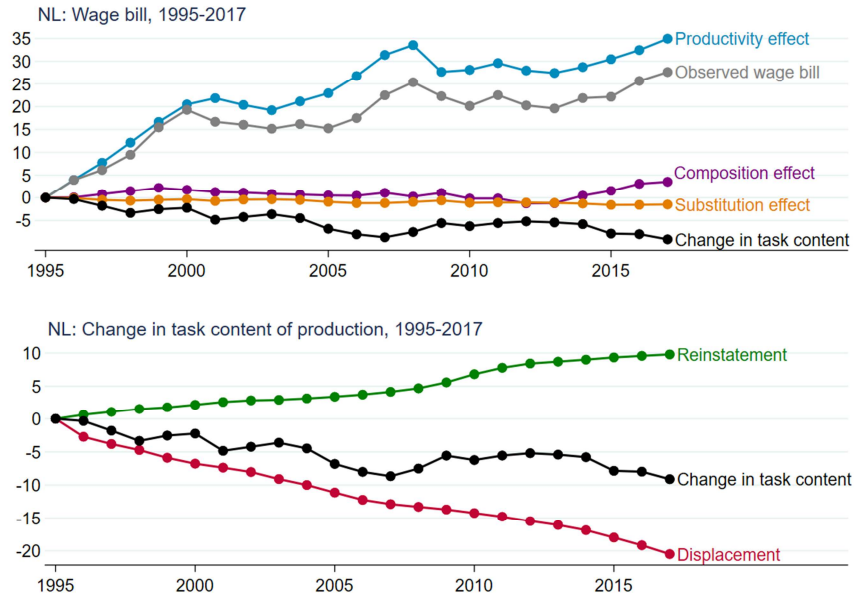

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Italy)



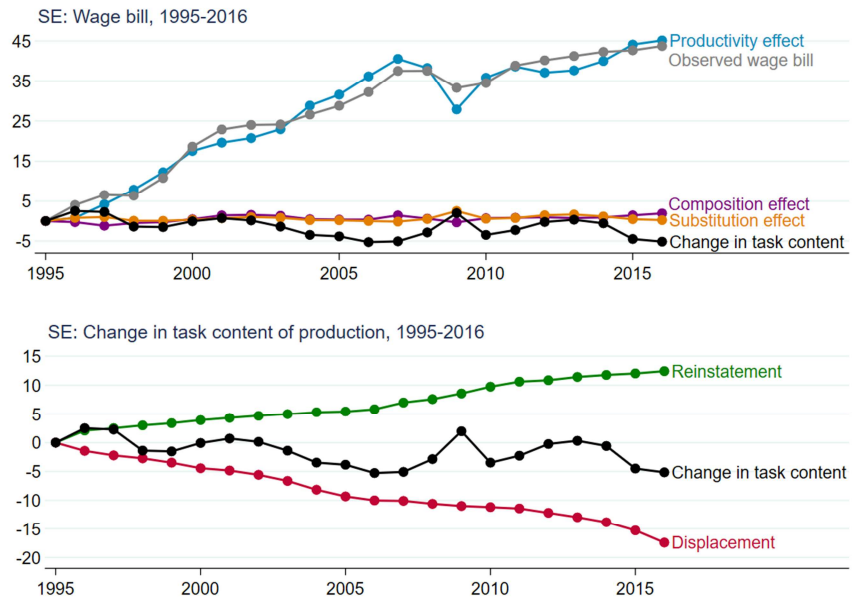

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Netherlands)



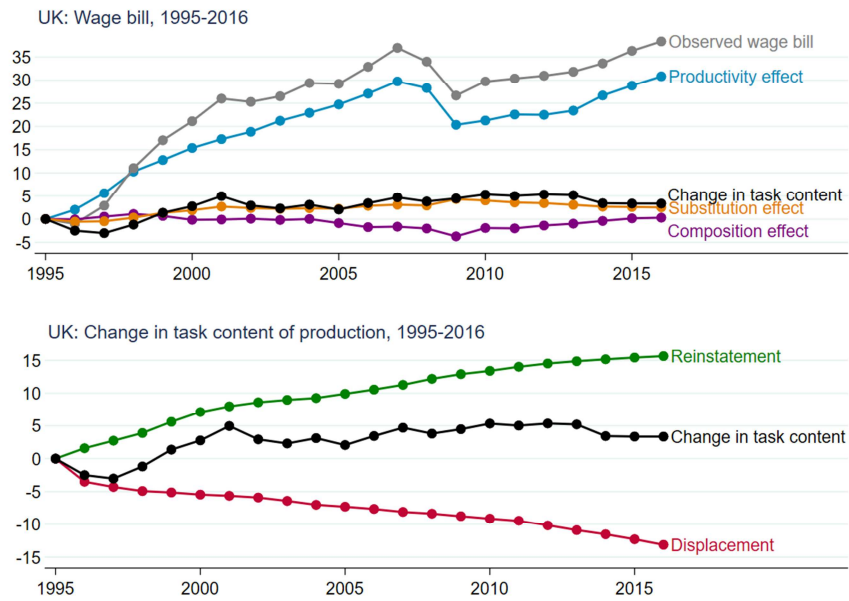

Sources of Changes in Labor Demand (Sweden)



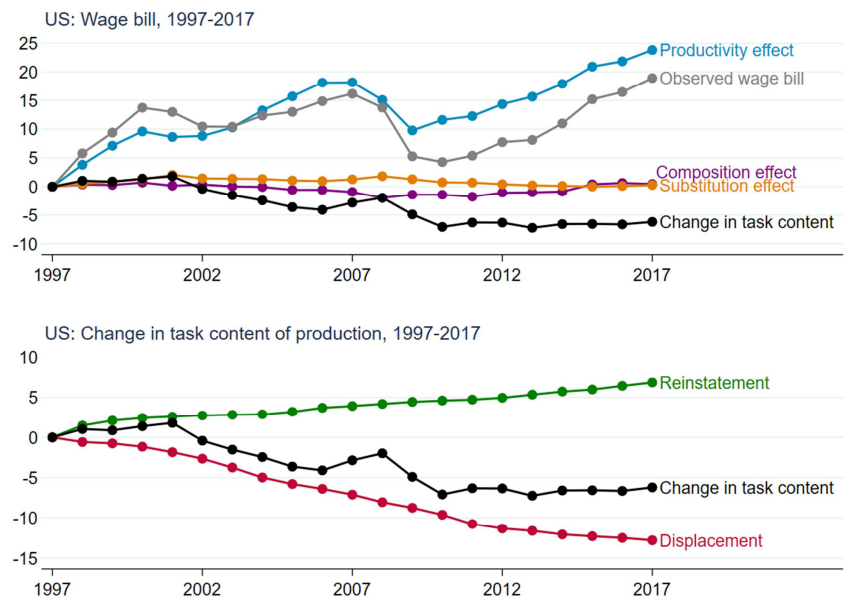
