On 13 November 2019, Net4Society is offering an event focused on the assurance and improvement of the quality of project proposals submitted for the 2020 SC6 calls. The aim of this Proposal Check Event for 2020 SC6 calls is to increase the chances for funding and to transfer useful knowledge to project proposers. As a proposer, you will have the unique opportunity to discuss your proposals with experienced H2020 evaluators and gain feedback on work already done.

Procedure

Interested coordinators present their almost finished proposals for SC6 2020 calls (see the list below) and receive qualified feedback from experienced evaluators immediately during the session. A dedicated counselling session consists of the evaluators reading the proposal, the proposers briefly presenting their project, and an ensuing feedback round. There will also be the possibility for receiving additional consulting by experienced NCP staff. To ensure confidentiality, all participating experts will be asked to sign a non-disclosure agreement.

Who can attend?

The event will support proposals for 2020 SC6 calls under H2020. Admission is open to the coordinator (i.e. one person, mandatory), plus one representative from a project partner institution (i.e. one optional person). In exceptional cases, the coordinator may name a proxy to attend in his or her place.

Please note that the evaluators on-site will not check to determine that proposals reviewed correspond to the specific call for which the proposal is written. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that proposers have an abstract of their proposal checked by the corresponding NCP.

Application

Applications must be submitted via the online registration platform by the project coordinators, who must also denote the second participant for the event. The submission of applications will be open from 30 September to 25 October 2019.

Selection of participants

To select final event participants, applications will be fed into a quality assurance process. From there, selected proposers will be contacted three to four weeks before the event (no later than 28 October) to assess the degree of completion of their proposals. Short-listed candidates will be invited based on the number of places available.

Participation in the event is free of charge. Net4Society cannot cover any travel-related expenses for proposers.

In addition to this event, we also encourage you to attend the the international information day and brokerage event for SC6 2020 calls for proposals, which will take place on the day before the Proposal Check Event, on 12 November 2019.
