1st call

Open: 2nd November 2020

 1st November 2022



2nd call

Open: 3rd May 2021
 Deadline: 31st August 2021
 Recruitment date: 1st February 2022 or
 1st May 2022



3rd call

Open: 1st October 2021
 Deadline: 31st January 2022
 Recruitment date: 1st July 2022 or 1st September 2022



All fellowships MUST be finished by 30th September 2025.

Two mobility schemes:



Reintegration scheme – is dedicated for Slovak nationals who have carried out their main activity in the Third countries at least for 3 years minimum (not in EU countries or the associated countries) within the period of 5 years prior to the deadline of application submission and who have resided or carried out their main activity in the Slovak Republic for maximum 3 months prior to the deadline of application submission;



Incoming scheme – is dedicated for scientists (EU citizens, or associated countries citizens and third countries citizens) who have not resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the Slovak Republic for more than 12 months in the last 3 years prior to the deadline of application submission.

Eligibility criteria for applicants:

Eligibility criteria for applicants differ in Incoming grants and Reintegration grants mentioned above.

Both are dedicated to experienced researchers that have to meet the main criterion at the date of call deadline:



possession of PhD. or equivalent degree;



research experiences up to 15 years after obtaining PhD. or equivalent degree.

SASPRO 2 Programme offers 40 positions within 70 potential Host Organisations covering various research areas and topics.

Researchers that are already permanently employed by the entity where the research training activities take place and that is recruiting them will be not supported.
