The Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences has set out this Seeing Science photography competition on its 200th anniversary (in 2008) to promote the communication of science, and more specifically the visualisation of the **magic** of science. The picture that captures the magic of science best wins.

The winners will receive a 1-year subscription to a magazine of their preference. The first prize winner will also be invited to an awards ceremony at the Royal Netherlands Academy of Arts and Sciences in Amsterdam in the last week of January 2008; travel expenses and accommodation costs will be covered.

Deadline for sending in photographs is **1 November 2007**.
