In 1982 I graduated in mathematics and I received a post of assistant lecturer and later lecturer at the Departement of Probability and Mathematical Statistics.

In 1989 I started my PhD study under the supervision of Prof. Neubrunn.

In 1991 I submitted my thesis "Generalized continuity of functions and multifunctions" and I defended my thesis.

In 1992 I submitted my habilitation work "Hypertopologies on function spaces" and in 1993 I took the degree of Associative Professor.

In 1993 my research project devoted to the study of hyperspace topologies was awarded by Italian CNR by 10-monthly stay at University of Milan under the supervision of Prof. Lucchetti.

In 2004 I submitted my disertation "Topologies on function spaces and hyperspaces" and in 2005 I took the degree DrSc.

Up to now I published 80 papers. My papers have more than 150 citations.
