As an archaeologist, I have worked in Slovakia, Germany, USA and Kuwait. Since 2003 the main specialisation of my work has been the study of ancient textiles and their production in the territory of Slovakia, with reference to the broader European context. My main research interests are textiles, basketry and leather in archaeology, experiments and reconstruction, Iron Age and Roman Period and laboratory excavation. Since 2006, I have been part of an international multidisciplinary project researching the unique Late Roman grave from Poprad-Matejovce, Slovakia. I have been analysing the collection of textile and leather finds from there a co-authored a permanent exhibition about the find.
